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**EMP 7674 – Relationship and Life Energy Geometry
(3 Credits)**

Overview of Course

The course will use geometry structures to demonstrate the energy relationship. To simplify complex relationships, one must understand structures of geometry, their energy, connections and relationship. Therefore, various kinds of geometry energy in living environment are analyzed with guidance from ancient wisdoms. The course will introduce how to manage events with right time, right space and right person using space-time energy geometry.

Course Topics:

- Overview of energy geometric structures and their relationship.
- Time, time energy and time geometry energy.
- Space, space energy and space geometry energy.
- People, geometric energy and relationships.
- Geometric relationship and space-time energy.
- Whole pictures of relationship with time, space, events and human life.
- Life relationship with energy geometry structures.
- Case study with space-time energy geometry.
- The art and applications of the relationship.

Learning Objectives:

- Students will understand of energy geometric structures and their relationship.
- Students will learn the key points of relationship with time, space, events and people.
- Students will recognize geometric relationship and space-time energy.
- Students will understand their own energy characteristics and enjoy a journey of self-cognition and confidence with art of relationships.

Audience:

This course is designed for individuals who have interests in self cognition and development through the ancient science and philosophy.

Course Description

Relationship plays an important role in our life. Behind the relationship, energy and nature law are big players. This course will offer simple tools to analyze complex relationships. In this course, the relationship covers the scope among nature, time, space, events and human life. This course uses basic geometry shapes to demonstrate complex relationships. The energy geometry comes from ancient wisdoms. Time and space are tools to study the energy geometry. Space-time energy helps us understand the nature law and relationships. In this course various kinds of geometry energy are analyzed, which are useful for life. After study, the students will learn how to use the relationship to manage events with right time, right space and right person using space-time energy geometry.

Faculty-Student Communication

Course Delivery Style

Course Assignments and Completion Timetable

Study basic energy geometric structures.

Assignment #2 (Week 2)

Understand the difference between time and time energy.

Assignment #3 (Week 3)

Study basic structures of time energy geometry.

Assignment #4 (Week 4)

Study basic structures of space, space energy and space geometry energy.

Assignment #5 (Week 5)

Study individual geometric energy.

Assignment #6 (Week 6)

Explore personal life experience and relationships with geometric energy.

Assignment #7(Week 7)

Practice relationships using geometric relationship and space-time energy.

Assignment #8 (Week8-9)

Analyze coincidence of events with concept of “right time, right space and right person”.

Assignment #9 (Week10-12)

Life relationship with energy geometry structures.

Assignment #10 (Week13-14)

Case study with space-time energy geometry.

Assignment #11 (Week15-16)

The art and applications of the relationship understand how to use the space-time characteristics of meridians to guide the medical practice.

Assignment #12 (Week17-20)

- Understand space-time energy linking with TCM, The Art of War and obtain deep understanding of energy and health.
- Summarize a paper with figures for this practicing experience according to assignment detail instruction.

Course Evaluation

The course grade will be based upon the quality of the assigned worksheets, practiced forms, figures and final paper, the comments and criticisms of understanding, exploration, application and session discussion.

Course Grading Determinants

Grades are based on the assignments and practicing.
