Term Project:

- 2) how does the information support or call into question existing beliefs and scientific theories?
- 3) what are the social implications?

All students are expected to present the project to me at least once before the completion of the paper. I will look at and comment upon any portion of your project as the course progresses. The final eloquently written, paper is <u>due two weeks before end of semester</u>.
